Agenda Item No-4

The SEAC has furnished the summary records of the minutes of the meeting of SEAC held on 30.11.10 and 6th & 7th December, 2010 as follows:-

1. The decision taken in SEAC meeting interaction meeting held on 26.11.10 was discussed. It was decided to return the original proposals to SEIAA after issuing TOR. Accordingly, the proposals for which TORs are already issued will be returned to SEIAA.
2. Letter No. 552 dated 22.11.10 of Member Secretary, SEIAA Orissa regarding conditions stipulated in item No. 14 of Category-B2 MI project was discussed in the meeting. After consideration, it was decided to explain for imposing such condition and a draft was finalized by the SEAC for the purpose.
3. The committee observed that SEIAA, Orissa is forwarding proposals on final appraisal for EC for which TORs have been issued by MOEF, Govt. of India for EIA study. It was decided to request SEIAA to forward the original applications submitted to MOEF, Govt. of India by the project proponents while forwarding proposals for final appraisal.
4. SEAC is receiving many proposals from the project proponents regarding the permission of CGWB for drawal of ground water where project proponents are furnishing blanket sanction of the CGWB on the plea that the area falls under safe zone. The SEIAA should bring this serious issue to the notice of the CGWB Regional and National authorities as well as the Water Resources Dept. Govt. of Orissa. SEIAA is also requested to take necessary steps to prohibit usage of ground water for construction and industrial activities.
5. SEIAA has forwarded half yearly environmental monitoring reports of the projects which have obtained environmental clearance from SEIAA and requested for review and assessment of such compliance report of SEAC. The committee felt that as per the EIA Notification, 2006 Para 10(ii) such tasks are not within the purview of the SEAC. So that it was decided to return such proposals to SEIAA.

Agenda Item No-5

The Members of SEAC have visited the site of the construction project of the proponent and summary records are placed below.

Tamarind Terrace Residential Complex of M/s Aryan Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd. Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar.

The site officials of the project were present. The committee observed the following:-

- I. Massive construction work was on full swing and one of the blocks was found to have been built up to ground level.
- II. The representatives could not produce the necessary BDA approved plan, they stated that BDA approval was obtained on their initial proposal of G+8 buildings, which was later modified for G+S+13 floors and the approval is awaited.
- III. They also informed that they are using ground water for construction work.
