Item No-1

The proposal was received from Sri Radharaman Alloys Ltd. on 21.12.09 for expansion of induction furnace at village Jharabeda, Rajgangpur, in Sundargarh district. The proposal was sent to SEAC on 22.01.10 which is now at pipe line stage of SEAC. In the meantime the proponent has requested to the Authority to withdraw the proposal. The proponent has deposited the scrutiny fees.

Item No-2

- i) Sri Probodha Mohanty of M/s Unchabali Iron & Manganese mines and
- ii) MGM Minerals have represented for extension validity period of Environmental Clearance issued to them. The representation of Sri Probodha Mohanty of M/s Unchabali Iron and Manganese Mines and Sri R.L Mohanty of M/s MGM Minerals Ltd. were sent to SEAC. Now it reveals from the minutes of the SEAC meeting dated 26.04.10 the SEAC did not considered the appeal of the proponent.

Item No-3

M/s OCL India Ltd for their proposals (i) E.C for 27 MW captive thermal power plant at Biswali and (ii) for expansion of cement grinding mill to 2.7 MTPA at village Biswali Tangi district Cuttack, have represented regarding delay in processing for issue of ToR in favour of the proponent. Original application of the proponent was received on 18.02.10 without scrutiny fees. The proponent was requested to deposit the scrutiny fees on 2.03.10 and the proponent deposited at the Authority on 4.03.10. Both the proposals sent to SEAC on 19.03.10

Item No-4

(i) M/s DD Iron & M/s Malati Steel Pvt. Ltd for (i) setting up 1X 4.5 Ton / heat induction furnace for production capacity 27000 TPA and (II) for setting up 1x8 Ton/Heat Induction Furnace to produce ingot of 26400 TPA respectively have represented for exemption of environmental clearance. This has been considered by the SEAC vide their minutes of the meeting held on 4.3.10. But both the proponents have not deposited the scrutiny fees.
