NOTE:-

The EIA Authority has received 230 no. of proposals like Mines, Industries, Power Plant, Irrigation, Building Construction from the proponents till 25.11.2010. Out of the above proposals 216 nos. of proposals have been sent to the State Expert Appraisal Committee for appraisal. The rest 14 nos. of proposals have not been sent to SEAC which are as follows due to wanting of information from the proponent.

1. For Barajhula quartz mining project at Barajhula Tehsil, Biramaharajpur Dist- Sonepur of M/s Arundaya Minerals and Trading Corporation.
2. For renewal and enhancement of production up to 35000 TPA of manganese ore at Teherai-Sonua iron manganese mines in the district of Sundargarh of M/s Tarini Mineral, Barbil, Keonjhar.
3. Production of graphite of 15251 TPA at Mahanilaha, Dist-Balangir of M/s Mahanilaha graphite mines At/Po- Harisankarpur Road, Balangir.
4. For concentrated chrome 9000 TPA at Analjhari in the district of Dhenkanal of M/s Kalinga Ferro Alloys.

The above 4 proposals were placed in the meeting of SEIAA on 25.2.10, 17.03.10 & 19.08.10 for depositing the revised modified Form-1 of application with other documents along with scrutiny fees. Accordingly the proponent have been requested vide this office letter dated 21.04.10 and 23.08.10 and lastly a date line was given to them to comply. But the proponent did not responded to the letter of SEIAA. Hence the above 4 (four) proposals dropped.

Three project proposals which are pending with MOEF, Govt. of India have been requested by this Authority to return the project documents as follows:-

1. Expansion of production of iron ore & manganese ore over an area 37.868 ha. at Bansapani in the dist of Keonjhar of Bansapani iron & manganese mines of Sri S.C Padhee.
2. Proposal for expansion of iron ore production from 0.93 LTPA to 2.04 LTPA and manganese ore up to 0.12 LTPA over an area of 12.942 ha at Nuagaon village in the district of Sundargarh of Sri Shiv Dutt Sharma.
3. For production of 2462 TPA of manganese ore at village Anajore in the district of Rayagada of Anajore manganese ore mines of K.K Das.

The rest 7 (seven) new proposals have been received which is under process and information has been sought for from the proponent.

Out of 216 no. of proposals 53 nos. of proposal have been received from the SEAC. Which are as follows:-

1. 20 nos. of proposals for Final Environmental Clearance with recommendation.
2. 12 no. of proposals have recommended by SEAC for grant of final EC.
3. 2 nos. of proposals for exemption from E.C as per EIA Notification dated 01.12.09 of MOEF, Govt. of India i.e. DD Iron and Malati Steel Pvt. Ltd. with recommendation.
4. 2 no. of proposals for withdrawal
5. 3 no. of proposals who is treated as category 'A' i.e. Pathapur Fire Clay Mines with recommendation.
6. 9 nos. of proposals which requires EIA/EMP report. The proponents have been requested to deposit the EIA/EMP report with scrutiny fees.
