**6. A letter 112/JNP/14-15 dt.24.12.2014 received from Bhanjapalli Iron Ore Mine of Sri J.N Patnaik at Bhanjapali, Koira, Bonai in the district of Sundergarh for 2,60,000 TPA over an area of 18.00 ha. –regarding**

1. The PP has informed that MoEF, GOI has lifted the capping of production capacity after examination of the report submitted by NEERI, Order of the NGT(National Green Tribunal) and the request made by Dept. of steel & mines, Govt. of Odisha to lift abeyance as it is leading shortfall in the mineral revenue of the state. Hence the PP has requested to be allowed accordingly & EC be granted for the same. The PP has submitted NGT order, Similar EC cases from MoEF, GOI, total payment of NPV from concerned authority, withdrawn case petition letter.
