The SEAC, Odisha opined that the concerned proceedings of the SEAC relating to the proposal recommending for issue EC was implicit. However, since the SEIAA, Odisha pointed out, it is clarified that the proposal was recommended for EC under category- B2 project as per MoEF & CC, Govt. of India OM No. J-13012/12/2013-IA-II(I), dated 24th Dec, 2013 as the proponent has proposed for transportation of raw material and finished products primarily through railways i.e. transportation by railways should not be less than 90% of the traffic (inward and outward put together).
