

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF STATE LEVEL EXPERT APPRAISAL
COMMITTEE, ODISHA HELD ON 28TH SEPTEMBER, 2012 AT 1100 AM**

The SEAC met on 28th September, 2012 at 11.00 AM in the Conference Hall of Odisha State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar under the Chairmanship of Dr. G. K. Roy. The following members were present in the meeting.

The following issues were discussed and decision taken.

1. Draft guidelines for quick disposal of minor mineral projects with mining lease area less than 5 ha was finalized in the meeting of SEAC held on 17th& 19th September, 2012. But same was not sent to SEIAA, Odisha for approval as it needs some modification as per discussion made in the meeting held on 21.9.2012 under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Odisha.

The committee deliberated on the issues discussed in the meeting held on 21.9.2012 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Odisha and opined the following.

- i) The MoEF, Govt. of India notified EIA notification on 14.9.2006. As per said notification, the project proponent has to apply for grant of environmental clearance in prescribed application **Form-I**. The MoEF, Govt. of India is only the appropriate authority to change/ modify or replace such application form. For speedy disposal of cases, if it is so felt, the SEIAA, Odisha may move to

MoEF, Govt. of India with suitable proposal to consider any change in the application Form-I in the light of **Annexure-II** of guidelines.

- ii) Approval of mining plan may be made mandatory for all projects of minor minerals with mining lease area of less than 5 ha as the same will be approved by the Director of mines (D.M.), Govt. of Odisha and in compliance with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, India dated 27.2.2012. For convenience at the best the idea of combining the pre-feasibility report and environmental management plan which in turn will be a part of the mining plan which may be considered by the appropriate authority (D.M) for consideration of SEIAA, Odisha. The project proponent shall prepare a simple mining plan (with proposed mining method and environmental protection measures therein) and cumulative impact of similar mines in the neighbourhood, if any and submit the same to the appropriate authority (D.M.) for approval.

The committee modified the draft guidelines as per above and finalized the same which is enclosed as **Annexure-A**. The committee also recommended the following.

- a) The SEIAA, Odisha after approval of the draft guidelines may forward the same to all concerned departments such as Steel & Mines department, Forest & Env. Department, Govt. of Odisha and to all the District Collectors for further action.

- b) The SEIAA, Odisha may also display the guidelines in the website and publish public notices in certain leading local dailies to intimate regarding the requirement of documents for minor mineral mining projects for grant of environmental clearance.
2. The SEAC, Odisha meeting to be held on 8.10.2012 for old proposals and 17-19th October, 2012 for the appraisal of new proposals.
 3. The SEIAA, Odisha forwarded 28 proposals for consideration. The committee decided the following on the above 28 proposals.
