

**Proceeding of the interactive meeting held on 9.10.2009 at 3 pm. In
the office of SEIAA Bhubaneswar .**

The interactive meeting of SEIAA & SEAC was held on 9.10.09 at 3 pm. Dr. C.R. Das, Chairman of SEIAA presided over the meeting. The following discussions were made.

1. At the beginning the chairman welcomed the members and informed that for better coordination the interactive meeting is very much necessary. He also explained about the way that the SEIAA and SEAC are to function.
2. Then Member Secretary of SEIAA gave a brief report about the activities of SEIAA till date. (Details are given in annexure-1)
3. Then Dr. Harekrushna Nayak the member of SEAC informed that State Pollution Control Board. Officers are helping the committees of SEAC for different activities. But they are doing this work in addition to their work in the Pollution Control Board. Therefore sometimes the disposals of the cases are being delayed.

Therefore it is necessary to take steps to see that proper arrangement is made for quick disposal of the proceedings of the meeting of the SEAC.

4. In this connection Dr. M.P. Patra pointed out that since there is budgetary provision for the appointment of one Environment Engineer & one Environmental scientist, steps should be taken to recruit such persons to help SEAC. He also suggested that if the present officers of Pollution Control Board, who are helping SEAC, are willing to come on deputation to SEIAA, then that possibility may be explored.
5. In this connection Shri S.S. Patnaik and Dr. S. N. Das also told that it is very much necessary to have to full time officers to help to SEAC for quick disposal of the cases by SEAC.
6. The Member Secretary of SEIAA told that till such experts are appointed by SEIAA Officers Pollution Control Board will continue to assist SEAC for all activities of SEAC. Till the conference hall of SEIAA office is furnished for the appraisal, the activity is to continue in State Pollution Control Board.
7. Dr. S. Rout told that some reference books may be immediately purchased by the authority, to which every member agreed.

8. The Secretary of SEAC agreed to give all the help that SEAC would require from State Pollution Control Board and necessary steps would be taken to see that the appraisal by SEAC and the proceeding of the meetings are circulated I time.
9. The members of SEIAA Shri P.C. Rath informed that it is highly necessary to have a retired level 1, S.O, from Odisha Secretariat who can manage the office efficiencely and keep the files and accounts of the authority and order. For the smooth functioning of the SEIAA &SEAC all members agreed for it. Immediately steps Are to be taken to locate a suitable experienced retire label 1. SO to take care of office.
10. Finally the Member Secretary of SEIAA said that all the discussion made by the honorable members of SEAC will be taken care and actions would be taken very soon about it.
