

## **Proceedings of the meeting of State EIA Authority held on 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2010 at 3:00 PM**

The meeting of the State EIA Authority was held on 11.02.10 in the office chamber of the Chairman of SEIAA at 3.00 pm. for considering proposals for grant of Environmental Clearance. Dr. C.R Das, Chairman SEIAA, Odisha Chaired the meeting.

1. Minutes of previous meeting was confirmed.
2. The following 3 (three) nos. proposals received from SEAC after appraisal for accordance were discussed and decided to examine further of the proposals.
