Whether constructions permitted and constructed before 2006 i.e. the date of notification of Ministry of Environment &amp; Forest stipulating environmental clearance for construction having built up area more than 20,000 sq. meter would require environmental clearance as mentioned above while considering the regularization of construction in the year 2009 which are undertaken in deviation from the approved plan and unauthorisedly.</p> <p>2. Whether permission is required for those constructions which were approved before 2006 and construction started before the issue of notification and completed after the date of notification.</p>	<p>Though the construction of the project has been completed before 2006, the same was an unauthorised one and was only regularised after 2006. To regularise the same, all necessary clearances are mandatory. BDA be intimated accordingly.</p>
